Since our last newsletter, the IRC has publicly launched the Indianapolis Circular Economy Initiative and announced its first policy objective. We've been talking about this new initiative, which is the manifestation of our strategic priority, since late 2018. And now, despite the continuance of a very surreal year, it's getting real!

The Master Recycler Program, which we've been talking about for over 2 years, is getting real, too. Thanks to start-up funding from the Efroymson Family Fund, the first module is taking shape nicely and soon, sponsorship opportunities for the

program will be available and beta-testers will get a chance to kick its tires.

We also got real with ourselves by eliminating programs that don't contribute to our strategic priority or aren't effective in a socially-distant COVID reality. Most importantly, we've intentionally aligned all new and continuing programs to contribute to our main focus, which is to:

advocating for local and state policy changes to
increase recycling and
strengthen the circular economy
for the entire state of Indiana.

As our commitment to this strategic priority becomes more specific and tangible, commitments from our critical partners across the state and beyond are being solidified, allowing us to do more and deliver results faster. 2021 holds great potential as we continue to expand our capacity and elevate our impact. So while it seems like an unlikely time to be excited, we are really excited.

INDIANA FOOD SCRAP INITIATIVE (IFSI)

Changes are coming to the Indiana Food Scrap Initiative's communication strategy! The IRC is refreshing it marketing and communications plan for its programs. As part of that refresh, the IFSI newsletter will now be included as an IFSI update in the IRC quarterly newsletter, not as a separate email communication. IFSI will no longer have separate social media accounts and food scrap related postings will be shared via IRC's social media accounts. - Food Waste Composting Strategy Group: In July of 2020, IFSI
 released a white paper on the State of Composting in Indiana. The
 paper compiles data and compares Indiana's composting landscape

- Food Rescue Strategy Group: The group is working on a white paper on the state of food rescue in Indiana, release date TBD. The paper will analyze data on the amounts and distribution of large-scale food donations and the access of Hoosiers to food distribution resources. The group is also preparing a flier on cold storage resources in Indiana.
